1.4.1 Institution obtains feedback on the syllabus and its transaction at the institution from the following stakeholders-

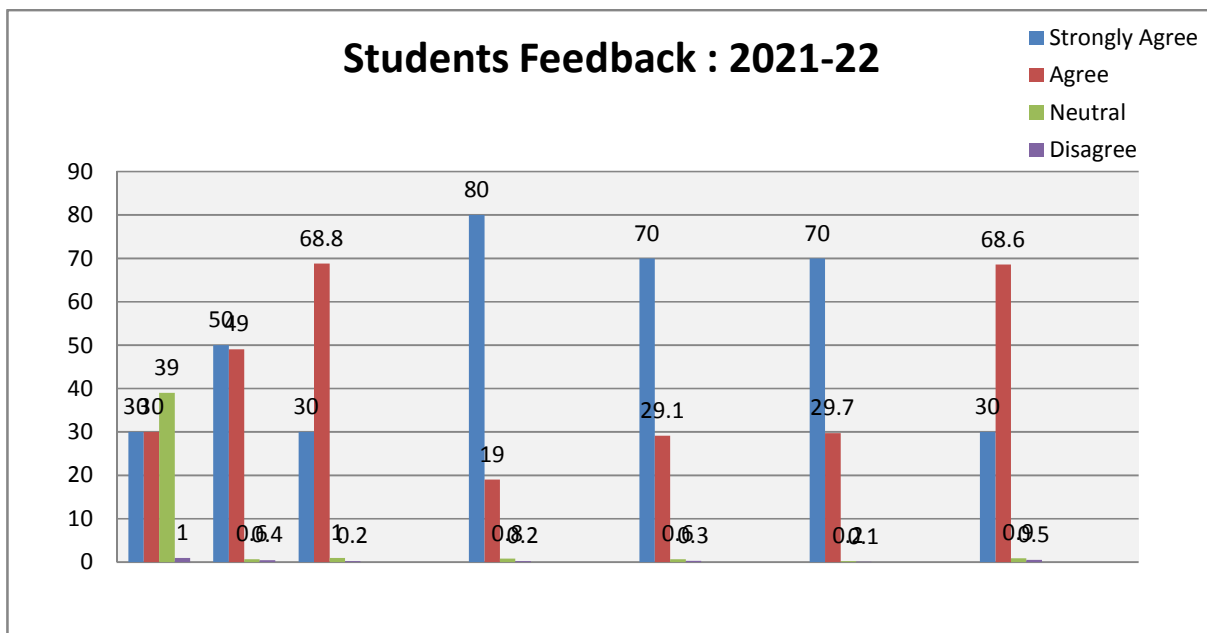
1. Students

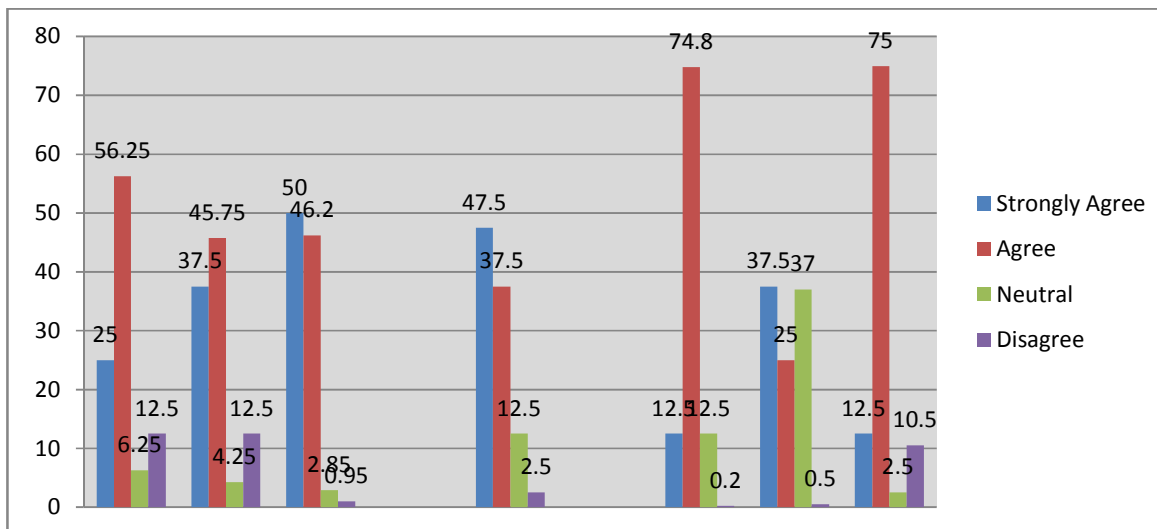
On an average 52% students are strongly agree, 42% are Agree, 06% are Neutral, 0.38% are Disagree with the current syllabus of the various programme .

## Teachers Feedback : 2021-22

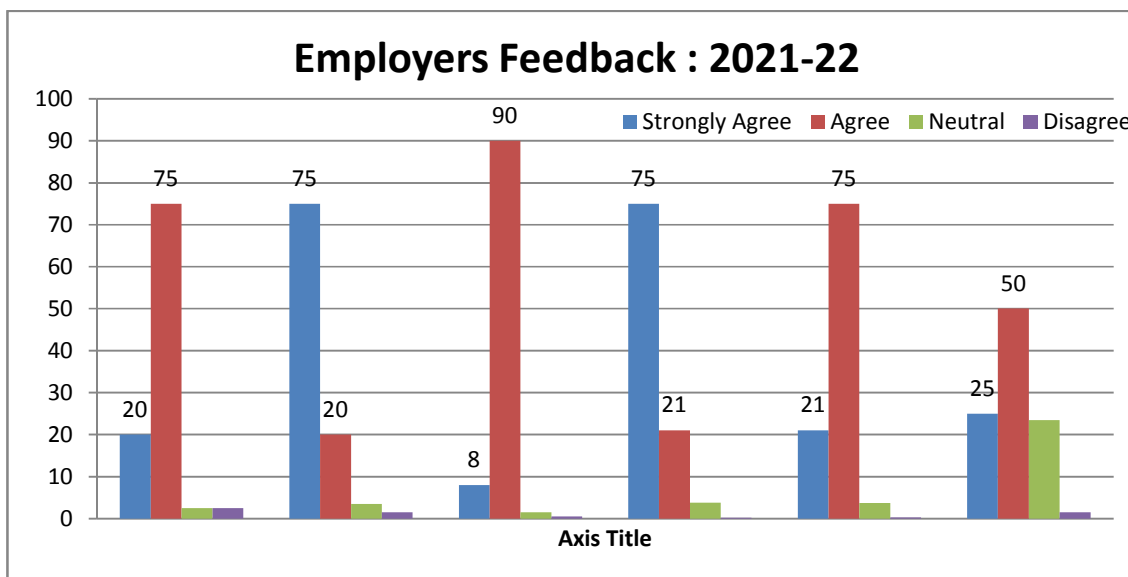


On an average 31% Teachers are strongly agree, 51% are agree, 11% are Neutral and 5% are disagree with the current syllabus of the various programmes .

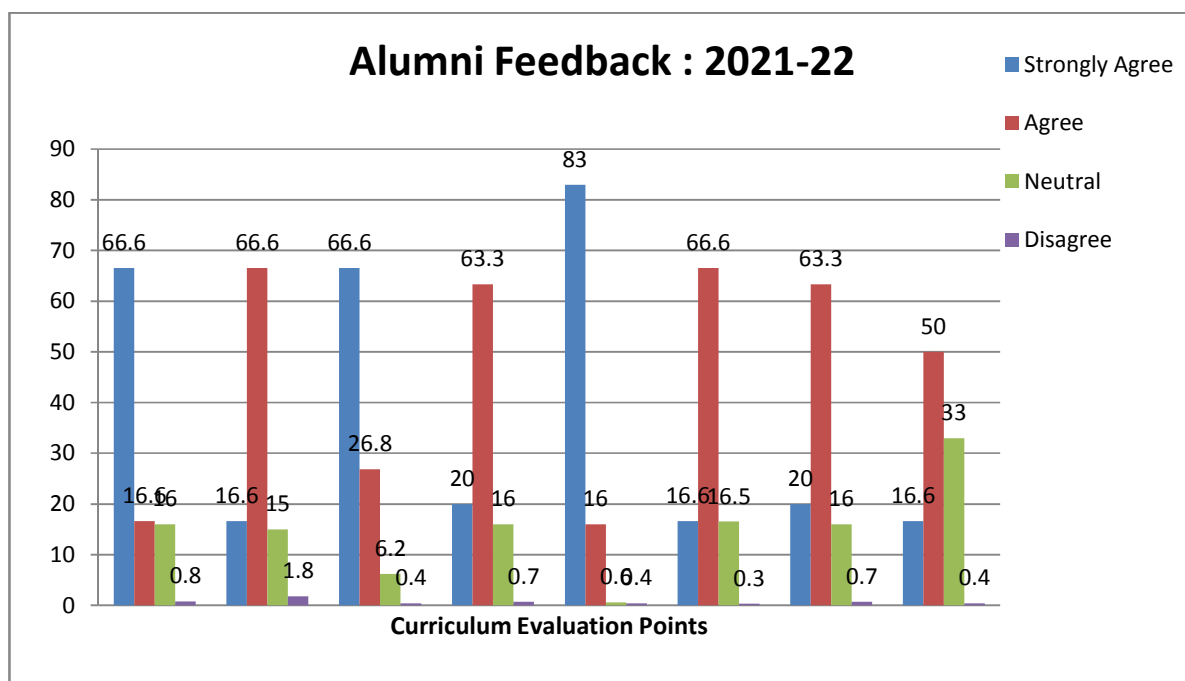
